National Sporting Code, Part VIII – Penalties

Amendments to NSC Part VIII in Manual 35:

1. Amend Article 94 as stated in the schedule below.

1. Item One:

- 94. Specific Behaviour, Which May Be Penalised:** In addition and without prejudice to anything contained in this Code or any Series Articles or any Standing Regulations of Supplementary Regulations, it shall be a breach of this Code for any Office Bearer, Member Club or any Associate Member organising a Series, Meeting or Event, or any Competitor, Entrant, Driver or Official in a Series, Meeting or Event:

(...)

- (g)** To abuse or threaten an official of any Series, Meeting or Event. The Clerk of the Course will hold a hearing to establish if an offence has occurred and if so found he/she will refer the matter to the Stewards for the application of a penalty. Should there only be one(1) Steward appointed to the meeting or event, the Steward may;

- (i)** apply a penalty under Schedule P NSC.7, or
- (ii)** refer the matter to MSNZ for penalty.

(...)

Reason:

To clarify process and penalty application.
