- The Permit is for a Clubsport Advanced Hill Climb.
- Minimum Licence Requirements for this event are Club Membership of a Motorsport NZ affiliated Club and a Clubsport Licence (M Grade).
- Maximum number of entries is 50. **Priority will be given to MSNZ Gold Star competitors. Entries Close at Midnight on Saturday 27th October, there will be NO entries on the day.**

All entries must be lodged online via the MSNZ Online system. If anyone needs advice on how to do this please contact the Organiser via email. Early bird entry fee is \$100.00, normal fee is \$125.00.

ENTRY FEES MUST ACCOMPANY ENTRY, OR THE ENTRY WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.

- **Scrutineering and Documentation** is from 8.45 am until 9.45 am at the venue and is in accordance with the current Motorsport Manual. All cars must be presented at scrutineering in a clean and tidy condition. Gold Star entries must have a MSNZ approved roll cage. Vehicles will be scrutineered to Schedule A & AA. To be eligible for Scrutineering to Schedule AA cars must comply with the requirements of Schedules K and T & C.

- **Classes:** Vehicles will be divided into the following classes:

(1)	2WD	0 – 1800cc	(2)	2WD	1801cc & over
(3)	4WD	pre 1996	(4)	4WD	1996 and later

For the purpose of the HBCC Club Championship the results will be converted into the clubs classes to allocate the points after the event.

Gold Star entries must use the same car if they competed in the Tarmac Round - Te Onepu Rd, 22 September 2018.

- **Drivers Briefing** will be at approx. 10.00am. This is compulsory for all drivers. One practice run will commence immediately after drivers briefing. Timed runs will start immediately after practice; and consist of three runs. If time permits at the end of the day, extra unofficial runs may be run at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course.
- **DIRECTIONS / TRAILER PARKING / SERVICE AREAS AT THE EVENT**
This will be at the finish of the hillclimb, also where the caravan will be positioned. Access to this northern end of Tangoio Settlement Road is opposite Kaiwaka Road on SH2 north of Napier heading towards Wairoa. When travelling to the northern end of Tangoio Settlement Road, you past the southern end entrance - please do not take this turnoff. Travel north to the finish end - the northern end will be signposted with a HBCC Event sign.
- Unofficial Practice or Recce on the venue prior to the event is PROHIBITED, the residents have been instructed to inform the event Organiser and provide a description of the vehicle. If you are found to be doing this, your entry will NOT be accepted. The HBCC Committee is treating this unacceptable Behaviour seriously and you may find you are also excluded from other events.
- No alcohol is to be consumed by competitors or their crew as this will result in immediate excluded from the event.
- The Prize giving venue will be advised at Drivers Briefing.

Carriage of Passengers

Passengers may be carried at the discretion of the Clerk of Course provided that Appendix 5, Schedule C, Part 1, Art 6 is adhered to:

- All vehicles carrying passengers shall be fitted with the following equipment, which must comply with Appendix 2, Schedule A: - Rollcage, - Both front seats, - four, five or six point safety harness for both occupants.
- Passengers shall wear safety apparel as specified in the safety schedule contained in Appendix 2, Schedule A.
- All passengers shall be briefed by the driver on basic event safety procedures, how to correctly wear and subsequently uncouple the safety harness and shall sign the Passenger Indemnity and Declaration Form prior to their participation.
- Passengers under the age of 16 are not permitted unless they hold a Motorsport NZ authorized minors licence, and between 12 and 16 years must present either a valid Junior Competition Licence or an underage indemnity form signed by a parent or guardian.
- Passengers may be changed between runs.

GOLD STAR Drivers who are entered are not permitted to be a passenger in any competing car (Championship Portfolio Article 10.2 applies).
