When approached by marshal the driver of car 9 took exception to the marshal wanting to assist with him getting out of the car. There was also some unacceptable words spoken to the marshal. The incident was also captured on TV footage. The incident was at the very low end of this type of offending	The Event Director rules that the competitor has apologised in person to the marshal involved who accepted the apology. No further action will be taken.
TRS ED 2	Dev Gore	The Event Director finds that during the New Zealand Grand Prix race you were involved in a racing incident with car 11. This caused both cars to leave the circuit. You then exited your car and struck the driver of car 11 with your hand in the head. You accepted that your actions were stupid and that you should not have done what you did. This is a breach of article 11 of the Castrol Toyota Racing Series Championship Articles.	The Event Director rules that Article 39.7 of the Castrol Toyota Racing Series Championship Articles applied. You are fined \$800.

TR86 1	Connor Adams	The Race Director finds that as announced in your race 1 an investigation was going to be carried out between you and car 17 as a result of an incident at T7. The Driving Standards Observers have viewed footage from TV and in car from your car and car 17. It is deemed you have breached Schedule CH 26.1. You didn't give racing room at the exit of T7 and Gained an advantage because of this.
