4.1.2 CHAMPIONSHIP REGISTRATION AND ROUND ENTRY

(...) 4.1.2 Drivers can register for ~~one or both of~~ the below competitions:

- (1) **TA2NZ Championship:** for all Drivers; and

- (2) **Masters Class:** for Drivers 50 years of age and above; and
- (3) **Trans-Tasman Challenge:** Round 2 – 7. Only New Zealand and Australian Drivers are eligible.

- (...) **6.1 Testing:** Testing is not permitted on any Circuit that is hosting a Round of the Championship within seven (7) days prior to the commencement of that Round, with the exception of Round 1 on Friday 18th September 2026 and Round 6 on Friday 20th March 2027.

14 AWARDS

14.1 The Class winners for each of the TA2 Championship, Masters and Trans-Tasman Challenge will be the Drivers accumulating the highest points after taking the total points awarded across all rounds and deducting their lowest point scoring round. For the avoidance of doubt, a nil point scoring round (including for rounds not entered) will be considered the lowest point scoring round.

~~The Class winners for both TA2 Championship, and Masters classes will be the Drivers with the highest accumulated total points earned during the Championship, for each Class.~~

- 14.2** The presentation of the TA2NZ Championship Award will be made at the end of the season at the MotorSport New Zealand Annual Awards Function.
- 14.3** Awards will be presented to 1st 2nd and 3rd in ~~both~~ each of the TA2 Championship, ~~and Masters and Trans-Tasman Challenge~~ Classes at the TA2NZ end-of-season Prizegiving Function.
- 14.4** **Rookie of the Season:** Will be awarded to the first year Drivers ~~of~~ in the TA2 Championship and Masters Classes ~~in the Championship~~ who have accumulated the most points in each Class for the Season. The presentation for these trophies will take place at the TA2NZ end-of-season Prizegiving Function.
