



2026 MotorSport New Zealand ClubSport Championship Supplementary Regulations Part One

1. JURISDICTION

The 2026 MotorSport New Zealand ClubSport Championship is being organised and promoted by the Ashburton Car Club and will take place on Saturday 14 March 2026 and Sunday 15 March 2026.

The Championship is being held under these Supplementary Regulations, the MotorSport New Zealand 2026 ClubSport Championship Articles, and the current MotorSport New Zealand National Sporting Code and its Appendices and Schedules particularly Appendix Five, Schedule C, Part One and Part Two.

3. EVENT DESCRIPTION

3.1 The MotorSport New Zealand ClubSport Championship is combination of three Events of different disciplines, comprising a Motorkhana, an Autocross, and a Bent Sprint, held over one weekend, with points from each individual event combining to determine the overall Champion as detailed in the 2026 ClubSport Championship Articles, which can be found here: <https://motorsport.org.nz/championships/clubsport/>

3.2 Event Venues: Location maps will be forwarded with Acceptance of Entry.

Competitors are requested to ensure all servicing takes place over a ground sheet and to take all rubbish away with them at the end of each day.

3.3 MOTORKHANA:

3.3.1 This Event will start at approximately 8:30am on Saturday 14 March 2026.

3.3.2 Venue: 226 Frasers Road, Maronan, Ashburton – signposted from State Highway 1, Tinwald.

3.3.3 Surface: Grass.

3.3.4 Tyres to be used must meet the requirements of the 2026 ClubSport Championship Articles, Article 2.2.1(h) (ii) and (iii).

3.3.5 The Organisers have chosen “Option B” for this event (refer to Championship Article 6.4.3)

3.4 AUTOCROSS:

3.4.1 This Event will start at approximately 1:30pm on Saturday 14 March 2026.

3.4.2 Venue: Frasers Road, Maronan, Ashburton – signposted from State Highway 1, Tinwald.

3.4.3 Surface: Grass.

3.4.4 Tyres to be used must meet the requirements of the 2026 ClubSport Championship Articles, Articles 2.2.1(h) (ii) and (iii).

3.5 BENT SPRINT:

3.5.1 This Event will start at approximately 9:30am on Sunday 15 March 2026.

3.5.2 Venue: Bonningtons Road, Wakanui, Ashburton – signposted from Beach Road, Ashburton.

3.5.2 Surface: Sealed Road.

3.5.3 Tyres to be used must meet the requirements of the 2026 ClubSport Championship Articles, Article 2.2.1(h) and (i).

3.6 RESULTS: The results will be calculated as per the 2026 ClubSport Championship Articles, Article 7.

4. ENTRIES:

4.1 Entries must be made through MotorSport New Zealand Online (motorsport.org.nz). Any entry will not be deemed valid until payment is received.

4.2 Opening and Closing Dates: Entries open with the publication of these Supplementary Regulations and Normal Entries close on 1 March 2026 at midnight.

Championship entries received after the Normal Entry closing date will be subject to a Late Entry Fee.

A maximum of 42 entries will be accepted for each Event. Full Championship entries will be given priority over Non-Championship entries. Non-Championship entries will be accepted in order of receipt and will be placed on a reserve list until Full Championship entries are confirmed. A Full Championship entry is defined as a competitor who has entered all three Events that comprise the ClubSport Championship.

Non-Championship Late Entries will be accepted up until 12:00pm (midday) on Friday 8 March 2026. Late Entries will only be accepted at the discretion of the Clerk of Course and may be limited. No entries will be accepted on the day for any of the Events that comprise the Championship.

The Organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry in accordance with the prescribed provisions of the current MotorSport New Zealand National Sporting Code.

4.3 **Entry Fees:**

Full Championship (all three Events):	\$300.00 *	Late entry:	\$330.00
Bent Sprint Event only:	\$180.00	Late entry:	\$210.00
Autocross Event only:	\$80.00	Late entry:	\$110.00
Motorkhana Event only:	\$70.00	Late entry:	\$100.00

* An early bird discount applies for Full Championship entries received before 1 March 2026. The early bird discounted entry fee is \$280.00.

Any entry will not be deemed valid until payment is received.

- 4.4 **Refund Policy:** Withdrawals received up to the close of Normal Entries will receive a 100% refund. Withdrawals received after the Normal Entry closing date and before the start of Documentation will receive a 75% refund. Any withdrawals received after the start of Documentation will not receive a refund.

5. COMPETITOR REQUIREMENTS AND UNDERSTANDING

- 5.1 It is the Competitors responsibility to read these Supplementary Regulations in conjunction with the 2026 Motorsport New Zealand ClubSport Championship Articles.

- 5.2 **Licence Requirements:** All drivers must hold, as a minimum, a Junior M Grade Competition Licence or higher, and current membership with a MotorSport New Zealand Member Club.

If the Entrant is other than the driver, an Entrants Licence in the name of the Entrant is required.

- 5.3.1 **Competitor Understanding:** In submitting their entry, competitors (Entrants and Drivers) are deemed to fully understand the relevant Appendices and Schedules of the current MotorSport New Zealand National Sporting Code, in particular:

- The Articles pertaining to protests and competitors' obligations.
- Appendix Two, Schedule A.
- Appendix Five, Schedule C.
- The MotorSport New Zealand Code of Practice – Fuel.

- 5.4 **Motorkhana:** All competitors will be required to wear overalls compliant with the current MotorSport New Zealand National Sporting Code Schedule A, Part One, Article 4.3(1) – A, B or C while competing, in keeping with the National Championship status of the Event.

- 5.5 **Autocross and Bent Sprint:** All competitors must wear safety apparel as specified in the current MotorSport New Zealand National Sporting Code competitor safety regulations detailed in Appendix Two Schedule A Part One.

6. ELIGIBLE VEHICLES

- 6.1 **Compliance:** All vehicles shall comply with Appendix Five, Schedule C and Appendix Two, Schedule A of the current MotorSport New Zealand National Sporting Code unless stated otherwise in these Supplementary Regulations.

Championship entries must comply with Article 2.2 of the 2026 ClubSport Championship Articles.


7. DOCUMENTATION AND SCRUTINEERING AUDIT INSPECTION

- 7.1 All competitors must present themselves at Documentation and Scrutineering for the checking of Licences and documents, issuing of competition numbers and applicable advertising material prior to presenting the car for Audit Scrutineering. Cars will not be cleared to compete until all these numbers and advertising requirements are firmly affixed in the appropriate places on the vehicle.


- 7.2 Remote Scrutineering is NOT permitted for these Events.
- 7.3 **Documentation:** Will be held from 5:00pm to 7:30pm on Friday 13 March 2026 for all Championship entries, at Canterbury Vehicle Compliance (CVC), 106 South Street, Ashburton.
- Documentation can be available by prior arrangement only for out of town Non-Championship competitors on Saturday 14 March and Sunday 15 March 2026, from 7:30am to 8:00am at the Event venues.
- 7.4 **Scrutineering Audit Inspection:** Will be held from 5:00pm to 7:30pm on Friday 13 March 2026 for all Championship entries, at Canterbury Vehicle Compliance (CVC), 106 South Street, Ashburton.
- Scrutineering can be available by prior arrangement only for out of town Non-Championship competitors on Saturday 14 March and Sunday 15 March 2026, 7:30am to 8:00am at the Event venues.
- 7.5 **Accident Damage:** Competitors are reminded that, in accordance with the current MotorSport New Zealand National Sporting Code Schedule A, Part One, Article 3.4(8), if there is significant vehicle damage sustained, it is the Competitor's responsibility to present the vehicle and Logbook to the Championship Scrutineer for inspection and notation of any applicable information or as requested by the Clerk of the Course.
- 7.6 **Roll Call and Drivers Briefing:** A written Drivers Briefing will be issued with the Acceptance of Entry. A Roll Call and supplementary Drivers Briefing will be held each day at the venue at approximately 8:15am, immediately before the start of each Event. Attendance by all drivers is compulsory – a roll call will be taken and failure to attend will result in a penalty as per the current MotorSport New Zealand National Sporting Code, Schedule P, Article 5, NSC.5.
- 8. OFFICIAL BULLETINS**
- 8.1 Official Bulletins may be issued in accordance with the provisions of the current MotorSport New Zealand National Sporting Code. They will be displayed at the Event Trailer for each discipline.
- 9. GENERAL INFORMATION**
- 9.1 As per 2026 ClubSport Championship, Article 6.1, passengers are not allowed in any of the timed competition runs.
- 9.2 Alcohol is not permitted to be consumed by any competitor or their crew at the event before or during the day's competition.
- 9.3 Tyres warmers or any method of artificially warming tyres is prohibited. Refer to the 2026 ClubSport Championship Articles.
- 9.4 Pursuant to the current MotorSport New Zealand National Sporting Code, Article 13, the Organisers advise that if less than 25 entries are received by the Normal Entry closing date, the Event may be postponed or cancelled.
- 9.5 Camping is available at the Ashburton Car Club clubrooms at 47 Wakelins Road, Winchmore, Ashburton. There is ample parking with toilet, shower and kitchen facilities on site. There is a \$10.00 camping fee and bookings must be requested in advance.
- 9.6 **Prizegiving:** The 2026 ClubSport Championship Prizegiving will be held at the Ashburton Car Club clubrooms at 47 Wakelins Road, Winchmore, Ashburton from approximately 4:30pm on Sunday 15 March 2026. A BBQ will be available, with additional details to be advised in the Acceptance of Entry.
- 9.7 Food and drink vendors at the Events will be confirmed in the Acceptance of Entry.
- 9.8 An Acceptance of Entry will be sent once all details are confirmed in February.


Test 1: Glove




Test 2: HATCHET
