1	Simon Wheeler	It is alleged that you have: Caused a Red Flag, during Qualifying. This is a breach of Appendix Four Schedule Z Art. 13.2 1(a) iii.	The Clerk of Course finds that: Car 6 left the circuit during the qualifying session and made contact with the barrier at Turn 5. This necessitated a Red Flag to be shown.	The Clerk of the Course rules that: Car 6 Simon Wheeler be moved three grid positions back in the starting grid for the next Race. Appendix One Schedule P A4.Z.4.
2	Steve Donaldson	It is alleged that you have: Caused a Red Flag, during Qualifying. This is a breach of Appendix Four Schedule Z Art. 13.2 1(a) iii.	The Clerk of Course finds that: Car 34 left the circuit during the qualifying session and got stuck in the Gravel Bed at Turn 5. This necessitated a Red Flag to be shown.	The Clerk of the Course rules that: Car 34 Steve Donaldson be moved three grid positions back in the starting grid for the next Race. Appendix One Schedule P A4.Z.4.
3	Marc Doran	It is alleged that you have: Breached the ride height requirement as laid out in the Formula 1600 Technical Regulations - Article 8.1.3. "No part of the car, except for the tyres niay be closer to the ground than 40 mm."	The Clerk of Course finds that: When your car was inspected for ride height at the conclusion of qualifying it was found to be below the minimum ride height of 40mm. This was confirmed by scrutineer Mark Butchart. The competitor claimed that the area of the chassis that was below 40 mm was damaged in an off track incident at the turn 2 ripple strip. After an inspection of the chassis by the scrutineer it was determined that this was almost certainly the cause of the localised low point.	The Clerk of the Course rules that: No penalty be applied. The competitor is advised to effect an immediate repair and get it checked by the scrutineer.
4	Gary Love	It is alleged that you have: Breached the ride height requirement as laid out in the Formula 1600 Technical Regulations - Article 8.1.3. "No part of the car, except for the tyres niay be closer to the ground than 40 mm."	The Clerk of Course finds that: When your car was inspected for ride height at the conclusion of qualifying it was found to be below the minimum ride height of 40mm. This was confirmed by scrutineer Mark Butchart.	The Clerk of the Course rules that: Penalty A2 A.2 applies: You are excluded from the qualifying results You are fined \$100 Your competition licence is endorsed for a period of 1 month - until the 28th of February 2021
5	James Askew	It is alleged that you have: Repeatedly hit the rear of Car 8 Sam Wallace in the Pit Lane after the end of the race. This is a breach of App 4 Sch Z 10.9 (2) not driving in a manner compatible with general safety.	The Clerk of Course finds that: After a hearing with James Askew, James accepts all responsibility for his actions. This willingness to accept fault is acknowledged. After Race 4 the Clerk of the Course witnessed the actions and has viewed them again on video. The actions were a breach of Appendix 4 Schedule Z 10.9 (2) in that the actions were unsafe.	The Clerk of the Course rules that: Penalty A4Z.10 applies. Car 24 James Askew be fined a sum of \$250.00 and have 20 seconds added to his race time. Additionally James Askew Car 24 is excluded from the rest of the Meeting, being Sunday 31 st January 2021. An endorsement of 3 months ending 29 April 2021 is also imposed.
6	Alex Little	It is alleged that you have: Disregarded a black flag with an orange disc and also disregarded a black flag. This is a breach of Appendix Four Schedule Z addenda to Sch. Z Flags and their meanings	The Clerk of Course finds that: From the outset of race 19 truck 15 emitted a great deal of smoke for almost all of the lap. Judge of Fact - track smoke Daniel Creswell ordered a mechanical flag be shown. Truck race radio advised truck 15 of this twice. This was not complied with after 2 laps. Race control then displayed a black flag. This was disregarded. Repeated race radio warnings were not heeded.	The Clerk of the Course rules that: Schedule P A4 Z.3 applies. You are fined \$100. You are excluded from the results of race 19. Your competition licence is endorsed until 31 March 2021.
7	Jared Pyke	It is alleged that you have: Failed to hold station while yellow flags were being displayed. This is a breach of Schedule Z 11.1 (3)	The Clerk of Course finds that: while yellow flags were displayed you passed Car #78. This was between flag points 4 and 5. A drive through penalty was applied and this was displayed at the start/finish line. This could not be complied with before the conclusion of the race.	The Clerk of the Course rules that: As per Appendix 4 Schedule Z 10.11(2), Schedule P A4 2.2 applies. 50 seconds is added to your race time.
8	Ben McConochie	It is alleged that you have: Failed to hold position while under Safety Car during Race 21.This is in breach of Appendix 4 Schedule Z. Article 14.2 (3).	The Clerk of Course finds that: By your own admission you passed Car 122 while the circuit was under Safety Car conditions. This is a breach of Appendix 4 Schedule Z Article 14.2 (3).	The Clerk of the Course rules that: A4Z.9 applies. Ben McConochie is to have 6 seconds added to his race time.
