1	Trent Montgomery	It is alleged that you have: made contact with car 88 at turn 9 during Race 4 causing it to roll. This is a breach of A4Z 12.1.	The Clerk of the Course finds that: After reviewing video footage from race control, you did cause an avoidable accident as per alleged rule breach.	The Clerk of the Course rules that: A4Z.5 applies. Due to time contraints, a drive through penalty could not be given in time and that 50 seconds be added to your race time.
2	Mark Stockton	It is alleged that you have: Jumped the start of Race 8, leaving before your start signal.	The Clerk of the Course finds that: You started the race before your flag drop. This is a breach of Schedule Z, Article 8.2.	The Clerk of the Course rules that: Schedule P, Art A4Z.8 applies. 5 seconds are added to your race time for Race 8. A time penalty board and flag were displayed.
3	Greg Kroef	It is alleged that you have: Jumped the start of Race 8, leaving before your start signal.	The Clerk of the Course finds that: You started the race before your flag drop. This is a breach of Schedule Z, Article 8.2.	The Clerk of the Course rules that: Schedule P, Art A4Z.8 applies. 5 seconds are added to your race time for Race 8. A time penalty board and flag were displayed.
4	Linda Grey	It is alleged that you have: Jumped the start of Race 8, leaving before your start signal.	The Clerk of the Course finds that: You started the race before your flag drop. This is a breach of Schedule Z, Article 8.2.	The Clerk of the Course rules that: Schedule P, Art A4Z.8 applies. 12 seconds are added to your race time for Race 8. A time penalty board and flag were displayed.
5	Ross Golding	It is alleged that you have: Caused contact with Car 76 during Race 9 opposite marshal point 10 and alongside pit entry lane. This is a breach of A47 12.1 Code of Driving Conduct	The Clerk of the Course finds that: You did cause contact with car 76 as per alleged. Video evidence is the suporting factor from race control footage.	The Clerk of the Course rules that: A47.5 applied. As it was the last lap a drive through penalty could not be aplied and 50 seconds will be added to your race time.
6	Kyan Davie	Ibreach of A47 12 1 Code of Driving Conduct	The Clerk of the Course finds that: After reviewing video footage from race control, and by driver admission that you did force car 29 off the track at Turn 8. Note: there was no malice in the contact and it simply seems you didn't see car 29.	The Clerk of the Course rules that: AZ.5* applies and that 50 seconds shall be added to your race time.
