1	Justin King	It is alleged that you have: Car #49 came into contact with you in car NZ3 at turn 10. This would be in breach of Sch Z 12.1 code of driving conduct.	The Clerk of the Course finds that: This is deemed to be a racing incident no blame can be apportioned to either driver.	The Clerk of the Course rules that: No further action to be taken. The drivers were given a briefing on the expectations of behaviour when passing a car and when being passed by a faster car.
2	Mark Stockton	It is alleged that you have: Sch Z 13.2 (1) (a) (3.) Causing qualifyig session to be red flagged and stopped.	The Clerk of the Course finds that: Car 30 caused the red flag by exiting the track into gravel trap at vulnerable point on turn 1.	The Clerk of the Course rules that: Penalty SchP A4Z.4 applies and driver penalised 3 grid positions for the next race.
3	Derek White	It is alleged that you have: Sch Z 12.1 Code of Driving Conduct.	The Clerk of the Course finds that: no blame can be apportioned to either driver involved in the collision (driver had left the circuit following hearing so notice not handed to him, but the outcome of hearing was verbally conveyed).	The Clerk of the Course rules that: No penalty can be applied.
