This was confirmed by Race Control.</p> <p>Schedule four – Schedule Z – rule 8.2 applies.</p> <p>In conformity with Appendix four – Schedule Z rule 10.12(1) a 'time penalty board' was shown in the race.</p>	<p>The Clerk of the Course rules that: You jumped the start of Race 2 – Pre 65</p> <p>Appendix one – Schedule P A4z.8 applies and 5 seconds is added to your race time.</p>
4	Piers Mingham / John Smolenski	<p>It is alleged that you have: Made contact with another car and caused an avoidable collision.</p> <p>This is a breach of Appendix 4 – Schedule Z – Article 12.1 Code of Driving Conduct</p>	<p>The Clerk of the Course finds that: Having viewed available video footage from Race Control and a competitor who was directly behind the incident, no one driver can be held accountable for the contact. No clear breach of driving standards was established.</p>	<p>The Clerk of the Course rules that: No penalty is applied to either driver</p>
5	Kristopher Mackie	<p>It is alleged that you have: You hit car #751 in the rear end. The result of the collision was that both cars failed to finish the race. This is breach of Appendix 4 – Schedule Z – Article 12.1 - Code of Driving Conduct</p>	<p>The Clerk of the Course finds that: Your vehicle did made contact with the rear end of car #751 in turn 11.</p> <p>This was an avoidable collision.</p>	<p>The Clerk of the Course rules that: Schedule P A4Z.5 applies. You are fined \$100. As you retired to the pit paddock and were classified as a non-finisher no time penalty is applied.</p>
