1	Dean Cook	The Clerk of the Course finds that: The Chief Time Keeper reports that Dean Cook #95 posted a time of 1:11.847 In Qualifying. This is in breach of his class Time bracket of 1:12.00.	This Is a breach of the 2022 Accredited Articles for Sport Saloon Cup. Article 3.4.	The Clerk of the Course rules that: 2022 Accredited Articles for Sport Saloon Cup Article 8.2 (1) applies. Dean Cook Car #95 has his Qualifying times deleted. Car 95 to start from the rear of the first SS Cup Race.
2	Dean Cook	The Clerk of the Course finds that: The Chief Time Keeper reports that Dean Cook #95 posted a time of 1:11.376, 1:11.645 and 1:11.879 during Race 8 SS Cup. This is In breach of his class Time bracket of 1:12.00.	This Is a breach of the 2022 Accredited Articles for Sport Saloon Cup. Article 3.4.	The Clerk of the Course rules that: 2022 Accredited Articles for Sport Saloon Cup Article 8.2 (2) applies. Dean Cook Car #95 Is excluded from the results of Race 8.
3	Andrew Brunton	The Clerk of the Course finds that: Race Control report that during Race 14 a Safety Car was deployed. While under Safety Car you have passed other cars on the track. This Is a breach of Appendix 4 Schedule Z Art 14.2 (3) In that overtaking Is forbidden. A Time Penalty Board and Flag signal was shown during the race.	This Is a Appendix 4 Schedule Z Art 14,2 (3)	The Clerk of the Course rules that: Penalty A4Z.9 applies. 5 Seconds Is added to Andrew Brunton Car #20 race time.
4	Eddie Iraia	The Clerk of the Course finds that: After a hearing that Car 124 Eddie Irala allowed room for Car 900 Choppa Stevenson Into turn one but failed to allow room for Car 61 Jordan Rae. A clear overlap existed for the length of the straight. This has resulted In contact between Car 124 and Car 61. Car 124 Is adjudged to have caused this. This has resulted In Car 124 hitting Car 900 and turning It around. It was agreed that several alternative actions were possible to avoid this happening but ultimately the hit did occur. This is deemed an avoidable accident.	This is a breach of Appendix 4 Schedule Z Art 12.1.	The Clerk of the Course rules that: Penalty A4Z.5 applies. Eddie Irala Is fined a sum of \$100 and has 2 seconds added to his race time for Race 8.
5	Flynn Mitchell, Andrew Brunton, Simon Wheeler	The Clerk of the Course finds that: After a hearing that Car 20 Andrew Brunton spun at Turn 3. This has been caused after slight contact with Car 18 Flynn Mitchell. Both Car 18 and 20 have overlap into the corner. Contact Is side on. Video is inconclusive as to the cause. car 20 has spun ending up on the racing line facing backwards. Car 63 Simon Wheeler has had to take avoidable action to avoid Car 20 and as a result contact with Car 9 Shane Roughan has resulted. No blame can be clearly apportioned to either car 18 or 20 for the contact.	No breach has been proven.	The Clerk of the Course rules that: No further action is to be taken.
