Car 99 on the left-hand side of the circuit, car 69 to the centre. This has broken the applicable side, front suspension on each car. Car 99 has been able to stop off the circuit and car 69 has continued along the circuit with reduced steering control. Car 69 has made its way towards the pit entry rather than stop in an unsafe position on the track. Car 15 while passing the slower car 69 has contacted by car 69 as the reduced steering of car 69 has moved it sideways towards the pit entry.
