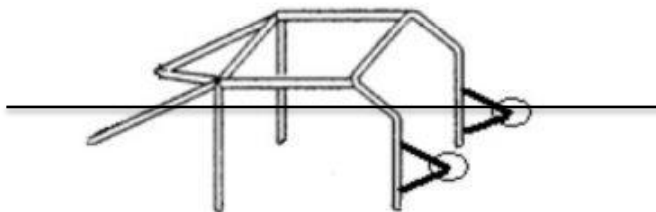
(6) Specific Requirements:

- (d) **Removal of a Manufacturer Occupant Protection System (MOPS):** from a vehicle (primarily used for motor sport competitions) may be authorised under the Authority Card system. The vehicle shall be fitted with and comply with the following:

(...)

- (ii) At a minimum, a full Safety Cage, in compliance with Schedule A, Part One, Article 4.6 and Part Two, Article 5.1 through 5.5 as per diagrams 8.3(6)(d) below. ~~incorporating forward reinforcements (terminating at a substantial structure such as the suspension strut tower) in full compliance with this Schedule; and~~

—Diagram 8.3(6)(d) — forward reinforcement —

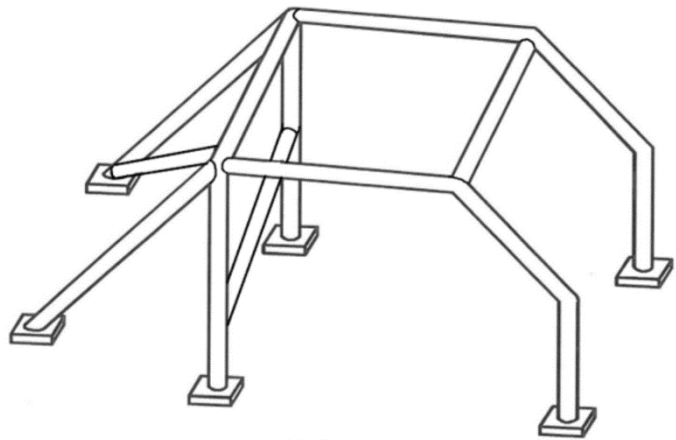
