Amendments to Schedule A - Part One in Manual 36:

1. Amend Article 8 – Use of Motorsport Vehicles on Public Roads as stated below.

1. Item One:

- 8. Use of Motorsport Vehicles on Public Roads:
 - (...)
- 8.3 LVV / MotorSport Authority Card
 - (...)
 - (6) Specific Requirements:
 - (d) Removal of a Manufacturer Occupant Protection System (MOPS): from a vehicle (primarily used for motor sport competitions) may be authorised under the Authority Card system. The vehicle shall be fitted with and comply with the following:
 - (...)
 - (ii) At a minimum, a full Safety Cage, in compliance with Schedule A, Part One, Article 4.6 and Part Two, Article 5.1 through 5.5 as per diagrams 8.3(6)(d) below. incorporating forward reinforcements (terminating at a substantial structure such as the suspension strut tower) in full compliance with this Schedule, and





Diagram 8.3(6)(d) – forward reinforcement
