## Manual Amendment 26094

### Amendments to Appendix One, Schedule LS – Licenced Driving Schools

1. Amend Part One, Article 2 as stated in the schedule below.

#### 1. Item One:

(...)

- 2.2 No applicant shall be issued with a Driving School Licence and no Driving School Licence shall be renewed unless:

(...)

- (7) The Driving School nominates a Senior Instructor who holds a current Driving School Instructors licence in accordance with Part Two of this Schedule.

~~(a) Holds a current Driving School Instructors licence in accordance with Part Two of this Schedule, and~~

~~(b) Holds as a minimum a current Level One first aid certificate, covering at least NZQA Units 26551 and 26552, conducted by the New Zealand Red Cross Society Incorporated or the St John Ambulance Association.~~

- (8) All on track sessions shall have the presence of the holder of a minimum current Level One first aid certificate, covering at least NZQA Units 6401 and 6402.

~~(8)~~ (9) Provided a Licensed Driving School holds at least one(1) valid licence for its Senior Instructor and that person remains on site to oversee the duration of each school, the school may engage the services of current or past C2 Grade or R2 Grade licence holders to assist in the running of each school.

**Reason:** Removing the requirement for the Senior Instructor to hold a first aid certificate and instead have a Level One first aid certificate holder on site.
