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2026 North Island 3 Hour or 500km Endurance Series, South Island 3 Hour or 500km Endurance Series, New Zealand 3 Hour or 500km Endurance Championship Sporting and Technical Regulations Article Amendment

This Amendment is issued under the provisions of the MotorSport New Zealand National Sporting Code Article 18(2) in confirmation that the following amendments, notices, or points of clarification have been authorised to the text of the Series and Championship Sporting and Technical Regulations of the above-named Series' and Championship. It is recommended that in addition to retaining a copy of this bulletin, all parties modify the text of the Regulations according to the following:

Article Amendment:

1. Amend Part Three Article 1.1, 3.1-3.4, and 4.1 as stated in the schedule below.

1. CHAMPIONSHIP STRUCTURE

Amend:

- 1.1 The 3 Hour or 500km Championship comprises the following eligible Rounds:

3. CHAMPIONSHIP REGISTRATION

- 3.1 Registration into the Championship must be made on the Championship Registration Form provided by the Championship Coordinator and submitted to the Championship Coordinator for acceptance prior to the first eligible Round they're intending to compete in Championship Round.

- 3.3 In the event that entries to the Championship Round are oversubscribed, preference will be given to Drivers/Entrants who have competed in either the 2026 North Island 1 Hour Endurance or 2026 South Island 1 Hour Endurance Accredited Series.

- 3.3 3.4 MotorSport New Zealand reserves the right to cancel the Championship if less than eight entries are received without affecting in any way it's power to award any title.

4. AWARDS

- 4.1 The following awards will be presented at the annual MotorSport New Zealand Awards Function unless otherwise agreed and will be aggregated based on the two highest points scoring Rounds in the North Island 3 Hour or 500km Endurance Series and the two highest points scoring Rounds in the South Island 3 Hour or 500km Endurance series for each Driver entered in the New Zealand 3 Hour or 500km Endurance Championship. To be eligible for the New Zealand 3 Hour or 500km Endurance Championship each Driver must score points in a minimum of one of the North Island 3 Hour or 500km Endurance Series Rounds and a minimum of one of the South Island 3 Hour or 500km Endurance Series Rounds.

Reason: *To amend the 2026 New Zealand 3 Hour or 500km Endurance Championship Structure.*
