

Competitor	Finding	Rule Breach	Penalty to be Applied
Brock Cooley	<p>The Clerk of the Course finds that: During Race 12, which was a handicap start, you were racing for position with car 26 and Caught a group of slow cars at Turn 8. On the run up the hill to Turn 9, you moved to drivers right to overtake car 10. Car 26 Was on your right, and you moved across on to him. This interlocked your wheels, and had the effect of pushing car 26 on To car 71, which he pushed into the wall, and "rode" the side of car 71, nearly rolling his vehicle. Circuit CCTV footage, onboard footage from a car behind you and onboard footage from Car 26 was reviewed.</p>	<p>This is a breach of rule: Schedule Z, Code of Conduct Driving - Article 15.2 – the onus is primarily on the overtaking vehicle and Schedule Z Article 15.3 - Any occurrence or series of occurrences involving one (1) or more Drivers, or any actions by any Driver, which is considered to have had a negative effect on any Competitor or Competitors is not permitted and will be penalised. These occurrences, may result in or from, but not limited to: • Causing a collision: • Forcing a Driver off the Circuit:</p>	<p>The Clerk of the Course rules: Schedule P, Article A4Z.6 applies. Careless driving causing, or likely to cause an incident. You are excluded from the results of race 12, and fined \$250</p>
