1.2 Qualifying and Practice Sessions: At each Round, there shall be a minimum of one (1) qualifying session with a minimum of fifteen (15) minutes duration, and one (1) practice session of with a minimum of ten (10) minutes duration.

1.9 Finishing Procedure – The last lap board will be shown to the leading Vehicle when it crosses the start/finish line after either:

- (a) 2 hours, 59 minutes of race time; or
- (b) such shorter race time as may have been determined by the Race Director in accordance with Part Five, Article 1.1110; has elapsed. The end-of-race signal will be displayed to the leading Vehicle on the next lap as at its completion of that lap.
