

# 2023 GT New Zealand Race Championship Articles Amendment

Bulletin Number: GTNZ-23-A002

Implementation Date: Immediate

Issue Date: 10 January 2022

This amendment is issued under the provisions of the MotorSport NZ National Sporting Code Article 18(2) in confirmation that the following amendments, notices or points of clarification have been authorised to the text of the applicable Championship Regulations. It is recommended that in addition to retaining a copy of this bulletin all parties modify the text of the regulations according to the following:

## **Championship Article Amendment**

- 1. Amend Article 7 as stated in the schedule below.
- 2. Amend Article 8 as stated in the schedule below.
- 3. Amend Article 9 as stated in the schedule below.
- 4. Amend Article 13 as stated in the schedule below.

## 1. 7. ROUND FORMAT

**(...)** 

- **7.3.1** Where an entry consists of two(2) drivers, both drivers must:
  - (1) participate in the Qualifying session, completing one timed lap each, and
  - individually compete in either Race One or Race Two of the thirtyminute races, and
  - (3) compete in Race Three the sixty-minute race.

**Reason:** To align race terminology as per previous amendment.

**8.6** The only permitted intervention with the vehicle during the timed CPS will be:

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- (i) a Driver change (if applicable) in accordance with Article 8.3(c).
- (ii) rolling the car back and forwards no more than 2 metres (the vehicle cannot be moved ahead of the point at which it stopped for the Pit Stop) to disperse brake heat. Tyre pressures may be checked, and external cooling fans can also be used to disperse heat from the radiators and brakes.
- (iii) Race Three Sixty minute race only: in addition to 8.6 (i) and (ii), Changing tyres will be permitted.

Reason: To align race terminology as per previous amendment.

### 3. 9. TYRE TYPE, ALLOCATION AND MARKING PROCEDURES:

**(...)** 

9.6 Tyre use during Practice: Any eligible tyre as outlined in Schedule GT may be used during practice, and do not require marking except at Round One where twelve(12) new controlled tyres can be used and presented for marking prior to commencement of practice. No previously marked tyres can be used or presented for marking at Round One.

**Reason:** To provide clarity on when marked or unmarked tyres may be used in Practice at each Round, due to the increased tyre allocation at Round 1.

## 4. <u>13. POINTS</u>

**13.1.2** Where an entry consists of two(2) Drivers, points will be allocated based on the finishing position of the car in Race One, Race Two and Race Three each Race irrespective of which driver was driving the car.

**13.3** Race Points Allocation: Each Class will have points awarded based on finishing positions within each Race, as follows:
