

2023 GT New Zealand Championship Schedule GT Technical Amendment

This amendment is issued under the provisions of the MotorSport NZ National Sporting Code Article 18(2) in confirmation that the following amendments, notices or points of clarification have been authorised to the text of the Technical Regulations of the above-named Championship. It is recommended that in addition to retaining a copy of this bulletin all parties modify the text of the regulations according to the following:

Technical Schedule Amendment

1. Amend Article 6 as stated in the schedule below.
2. Amend Article 11 as stated in the schedule below.

1. 6.0 VEHICLE INTERIOR

(...)

- 6.3 Driver drink container** with a maximum volume of 2.0 Litres may be installed for driver hydration. The container shall be of propriety manufacture only, shall be mounted behind the driver's seat or as approved by the Championship Technical Officer, and shall be wholly within the driving compartment. Only one drink container is permitted.

Reason: To allow for factory fitted driver drink containers.

2. 11.0 ROAD WHEELS & TYRES

- 11.1 Wheels:** shall be a size compatible with the Control Tyre.
Tyres: shall be Michelin Dry with the following specifications except for the Ferrari 488 Challenge which shall run Pirelli tyres due to non-availability of the correct size Michelin tyres:
