<p>Notes for the Scrutineer You MUST complete steps 1,2 & 3</p> <p>The Scrutineer shall ensure that the scrutineering audits are carried out in accordance with Motorsport NZ guidelines and that no less than 15% of the competing vehicles at the event are audited.</p> <p>Any vehicle may be selected and an entrant may ask for his vehicle to be audited, but the following MUST be audited.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ❖ Vehicles with outstanding defects. ❖ Vehicles which have not been audited at the last two events entered. ❖ Vehicles and or competitors known to be competing for the first time. ❖ Vehicles with out a Motorsport NZ log book. <p>Before the Trial begins establish how many Vehicles will be audited.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ❖ 1– 6, cars audit at least 1 ❖ 6 – 13, cars audit at least 2 ❖ 14– 20, cars audit at least 3 ❖ 21– 26, cars audit at least 4 ❖ 26– 33, cars audit at least 5 <p>Before the Trial begins establish which items will be checked.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ❖ At least 3 items from Category 1 ❖ At least 2 items from Category 2. ❖ At least 1 items from Category 3 ❖ Entrant must present vehicle logbook and Membership card. <p>1. When scrutineering use the Entrant Declaration form. Check the items on your check list</p> <p>NOTE: you do not have to Scrutineer every vehicle or every item.</p> <p>2. After the vehicle has been checked, sign the declaration form and fill in the Entrants log book</p> <p>3. When scrutineering is complete.
