2023-24 GT New Zealand Championship Race Series

This amendment is issued under the provisions of the MotorSport NZ National Sporting Code Article 18(2) in confirmation that the following amendments, notices or points of clarification have been authorised to the text of the Series Articles of the above-named Series. It is recommended that in addition to retaining a copy of this bulletin, all parties modify the text of the regulations according to the following:

Championship Article Amendment:

- 1. Amend Article 7, as stated in the schedule below.
- 2. Amend Appendix Two, Article A2.38.
- 1. Item One:

7. BALANCE OF PERFORMANCE COMPULSORY PIT STOP

- (...)
- 7.1.4 Should a driver be prevented from taking the CPS due to either:
 - (a) A Safety Car period, or
 - (b) The Race is concluded in accordance with Schedule Z 9.2 (3) or Championship Article 6.6.

then Penalty A2.38(4) shall be applied.

Reason: Provision added for when a safety car period prevents the CPS taking place.

| | | 4. A Safety Car, Red Flag or Force Majure prevents a competitor completing their CPS, then, that drivers race distance shall be reduced by one(1) lap, and the CPS time added as a time penalty, or | |
| | | 5. A Competitor who is found not to have completed a CPS during normal race conditions at all, exclusion from the race. | |

Reason: Additional penalties added to provide for different circumstances.
