Simon Baker	<b>The Clerk of the Course finds that:</b> During Race 22, there was contact between you and car 17 in Turn 10. In the middle of the corner there was a secondary contact, which disadvantaged car 17 and caused damage to your car, which retired from the race.	<b>This is a breach of rule:</b> Sch Z App 4, 12.1 Code of Conduct Driving - causing a collision.	<b>The Clerk of the Course rules:</b> Schedule P Article A42.6 applies. You are fined \$250 and your license is endorsed for 6 months.
Simon Baker	<b>The Clerk of the Course finds that:</b> During your qualifying session you had an incident at T8, causing a red flag to be issued	<b>This is a breach of rule:</b> Sch Z App 4, 12.1- causing a red flag during qualifying	<b>The Clerk of the Course rules:</b> Schedule P Article A42.4 applies. You are moved back 3 places for your race 1.
Elton Wichman	<b>The Clerk of the Course finds that:</b> During your qualifying session you stopped on circuit at T7, causing a red flag to be issued	<b>This is a breach of rule:</b> Sch Z App 4, 12.1-causing a red flag during qualifying	<b>The Clerk of the Course rules:</b> Schedule P Article A42.4 applies. You are moved back 3 places for your race 1.
Simon Baker	<b>Details of Inquiry:</b> Car 17 smashed into my left front at the final turn, damaged car and punctured the oil cooler.	<b>This is a breach of rule:</b>	<b>The Clerk of the Course decides that:</b> Incident involving car 11 and 17 on entry to turn 10 - following the hearing and viewing footage neither driver wholly or predominantly to blame, racing incident and no further action to be taken.
Warren Crowther	<b>Details of Inquiry:</b> Braking into turb 4, Simon Baker was on the outside of my left. I was travelling straight, leaving him room on the left and he turned into me, hitting my rear left corner. He had no reason to do so, video evidence shows him clearly turning suddenly.	<b>This is a breach of rule:</b>	<b>The Clerk of the Course decides that:</b> No advantage gained - unable to action.
Matt Horne	<b>Details of Inquiry:</b> Had over lap on Car 43 going into turn 4, he has turned across on me making contact, this damaged my left front tyre deflating it taking me out of the race. I had to limp home last and 1 lap down.	<b>This is a breach of rule:</b>	<b>The Clerk of the Course decides that:</b> Driver decided to withdraw their inquiry at 1530
Simon Baker	<b>Details of Inquiry:</b> Car 61 Forced me off the circuit at Turn 1	<b>This is a breach of rule:</b>	<b>The Clerk of the Course decides that:</b> Having reviewed CCTV footage - racing incident and no further action to be taken
Simon Baker	<b>The Stewards find that:</b> the incident between car 11 and 17 at the entry to turn 10 is a racing incident. This lead to further contact by car 11 which has been identified and penalised for by CotC Decision #006.	<b>The Stewards rule that:</b> There is no further action to be taken against Car 17.	<b>The Stewards rules:</b> No further action.
