Gary Price	The Clerk of the Course finds that: You were not able to produce a valid vehicle logbook at documentation.	This is a breach of rule: Appendix 4 Schedule Z 4.2 (2)	The Clerk of the Course rules: Schedule P. A2A.1 applies. You are fined \$50. This is a mandatory penalty. <u>This vehicle must be safety audited at the next event it is presented to compete in.</u>
Josh O'Rourke	The Clerk of the Course finds that: Your car stopped at 1042 h at marshal point 11 (entrance to pit lane) Race control deemed this to be a dangerous position. The session was suspended at 1043 h.	This is a breach of rule: Stopping a qualifying session is a breach of Appendix Four – Schedule Z – rule 13.2 (1)(a)(iii)	The Clerk of the Course rules: Appendix One- Schedule P – A4Z4.1 applies. You are moved back 3 grid places for your first race.
Rhys Gould	The Clerk of the Course finds that: Your car made contact with car #148 (Garry Derrick) in turn 1 of Race 1 for Group A. Gerry subsequently retired and was a DNF. You admitted making contact.	This is a breach of rule: Appendix 4 – Schedule Z 15.3 - Code of Driving Conduct - 'Causing a collision'	The Clerk of the Course rules: Schedule P A4 Z.5 applies. 10 seconds is added to your race time.
Garry Price	The Clerk of the Course finds that: You made contact with car #51 (Nick Wright) at turn 9 during the 20 minute 'Fast and Furious' race. This occurred at 1508 h approx. This contact was witnessed by three flag points who provided reports. Race Control also had good quality video of the incident. This contact was admitted by you.	This is a breach of rule: Causing an avoidable collision is a breach of Appendix 4 Schedule Z article 15.3 (Code of Driving Conduct)	The Clerk of the Course rules: Appendix One Schedule P A4.5 applies. 30 seconds is added to your race time.
