YOUR OBLIGATIONS

If you have been fined, the National Sporting Code (PART VIII – Penalties – Article 97) requires you to pay OR contact the MotorSport New Zealand Office **within 48 hours of receiving a Notification of Decision**.

Payments can be made by completing the credit card section on the Decision Form (on the day or by providing credit card details to the MotorSport New Zealand Office) or Direct Credit to ASB Bank 12-3192-0017344-00 - Please use your Name and FINE as reference. Cheques and cash are not accepted at the office.

If you have had your Competition Licence endorsed, you are required to retain the decision form and present it on demand should you be called to any further hearing(s) during the period of licence endorsement.

All fines must be paid, even if it is undergoing review. If at a later date it is overturned, the fees will be refunded.

YOUR RIGHTS

You have the Right of Appeal, in accordance with the provision of the National Sporting Code, to the National Court of Appeal.

If you decide that you wish to exercise this right, then:

1. Consult the National Sporting Code Part IX- Protests.
2. Ensure that all fines, costs and/or charges are paid immediately.
3. Obtain from the Stewards, Clerk of the Course or Competitor Relations Officer a copy of the Court of Appeal Practice Guidelines.
4. The “Notice of Appeal” (in writing accompanied by the Appeal fee) must be received by the Secretary National Court of Appeal at MotorSport New Zealand with three working days of receiving the decision.

MOTORSPORT NEW ZEALAND OFFICE- PROCESSES

Event Documentation is provided to the MotorSport New Zealand office for processing after each event, this includes all fines and endorsements. All decisions are recorded and published.

If a fine is unpaid, an invoice will be generated and emailed to the competitor/entrant. As per above, this must be paid or a discussion with the office must take place within 48 hours.

Unpaid fines can lead to the suspension of your Competition/Entrants licence until fines are paid.

Endorsements and/or Suspensions are processed within the MotorSport New Zealand database which will provide automated emails to the competitor.
