Elliot Henderson	The Clerk of the Course finds that: In your qualifying session your vehicle stopped facing the wrong way in the carousel. Having waited for 15 seconds Race Control deemed this to be an unsafe position and the qualifying session was suspended at 1023 h.	This is a breach of rule: Stopping a qualifying session is a breach of Appendix Four- Schedule Z -rule 13.2 (l)(a)(iii)	Penalty to be Applied: Appendix One- Schedule P -A4Z4.l applies You are moved back 3 grid places for your next race.
Hamish Wilton	The Clerk of the Course finds that: Made contact with car #148 (Garry Derrick) during Race 2 of the Sprint Series Class A. This occurred in the Carousel. Video from your car and Race Control was reviewed several times by the Clerk of the Course and the Driving Standards Observer. The incident was also viewed in real time by Race Control. Causing avoidable collisions and forcing another driver off the track are breaches of Appendix 4 Schedule Z article 12.1 (Code of Driving Conduct)	This is a breach of rule: You did contact car 148. This resulted in both cars leaving the track and a red flag being called. Both cars #148 and #97 were DNF. This was an avoidable collision. Insufficient racing room was allowed to car #148 which was on the inside of the corner and had established clear overlap.	Penalty to be Applied: Appendix One Schedule P A4.5 applies. 15 seconds is added to your race time.
