Sam Dashfield	The Clerk of the Course finds that: You made contact with car INZ (Simon Baker) at Turn 8 during Race 2. Race control had no video evidence of contact from on course cameras No TV footage was available of the incident. Having reviewed both in car videos I conclude that you did make contact with car INZ. This contact was avoidable. This incident is viewed as having been at the lower end of the scale.	This is a breach of rule: Causing and avoidable collision is a breach of App. 4 Schedule Z article 15.4	The Clerk of the Course rules: 5 second is added to your race time. A penalty of 5 series is applied as per article 8.2 (1) of your Accredited Series Articles
Stiaan Kriel	The Clerk of the Course finds that: You operated your competition vehicle outside of the circuit on a public road. You admitted doing this in order to test a new gearbox.	This is a breach of rule: This is a breach of App. 4 Schedule Z - Code of Driving Conduct article 15.4	The Clerk of the Course rules: Penalty NSC NSC.4 (b) applies You are fined \$100
Stuart Lawton	The Clerk of the Course finds that: Your car made contact with car 67 in Turn 12 during race 3. In car footage from your car and the digital driving standards equipment located in race control was reviewed. Having reviewed both videos I conclude that you did make contact with car 67. This contact while minor was avoidable.	This is a breach of rule: Causing and avoidable collision is a breach of App. 4 Schedule Z article 15.4	The Clerk of the Course rules: 5 second is added to your race time. A penalty of 5 series points is applied as per article 8.2 (1) of your Accredited Series Articles
