William Neale	The Race Director finds that: during Race 2 vehicles #28 & #69 have impacted at Turn 5, after reviewing the video footage supplied and listening to testimony from drivers of both vehicles. It has been deemed an avoidable incident as vehicle #69 has an overlap prior to Turn 5, and you have failed to give 'racing room' which has resulted in both vehicles colliding and vehicle #28 spinning	This is a breach of rule: Appendix 4 Schedule Z 15.3	The Race Director rules: Appendix 1 Schedule P A4Z.6 Applies 30 seconds is added to your race time in Race 2 You are fined \$200.00
Ryan Low	The Race Director finds that: during Race 3 vehicles #37 & #75 have impacted at Turn 7, after reviewing the video footage, supplied via the broadcast team, and listening to testimony from drivers of both vehicles. It has been deemed an avoidable incident as vehicle #75 has been impacted and resultant damage from impact meaning that the vehicle was unable to complete the race, also causing a localised yellow flag at the point of the track for the remaining laps of the race.
