This amendment is issued under the provisions of the MotorSport NZ National Sporting Code Article 18(2) in confirmation that the following amendments, notices or points of clarification have been authorised to the text of the Series Articles of the above-named Championship. It is recommended that in addition to retaining a copy of this bulletin, all parties modify the text of the regulations according to the following:

Championship Article Amendment:

1. Amend Article 15 as stated in the schedule below.

Item One: 1.

SCRUTINEERING 15.

- 15.1 All other registered entries (except those entered in Category 3 and Category 5B), are not eligible for remote Safety Audits even if these are provided for in the Supplementary Regulations to any Round of the Championship.
 - Category 3 & Category 5B cars are only eligible for remote safety audits provided the Championship Scrutineer's permission has been obtained in writing. Only Scrutineers approved by the Championship Scrutineer shall perform the safety audit.
- 15.2 All Championship registered vehicles (except those entered in Category 3 and Category 5B) shall be presented to the Championship Scrutineers (or their delegate) at Event Scrutineering at all Rounds of the Championship entered for preliminary checks, checking of turbocharger restrictors, vehicle weighing, the application of any relevant Official Seals (refer Schedule A, Part One Article 3.7), checking of driver safety equipment (Refer Article 18) and checking of Championship decals. The Championship Scrutineer or their delegate will decide if the vehicle is required for any technical or safety inspections.
- 15.2.1 All Championship registered entries (including those entered in Category 3 and Category 5B), must present their vehicle logbooks at Event Scrutineering for checking at all Rounds.

Reason: As Category 3 and Category 5B vehicles are open two wheel drives, and eligibility is only subject to Schedule A requirements, allowance has been given subject to specific conditions.
