

NEW COMPETITOR BRIEFING CHECKLIST

Important Notes for users of this template:

The New Competitor Briefing must be conducted in a suitably quiet venue providing some degree of shelter. When covering all the subjects mentioned below it is recommended that you tick each subject after completion.

Samples of ALL signs used should be included at the venue.

All competitors should have a working knowledge of the MotorSport Manual, and this briefing should serve to remind them of correct procedures and to physically show them the signs used. The briefing should not take longer than 20 minutes to complete.

It is mandatory to take a roll call to ensure that ALL novice competitors are present.
