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2025-26 NZ Sports Car Racing Series Article Amendment

This amendment is issued under the provisions of the MotorSport NZ National Sporting Code Article 18(2) in confirmation that the following amendments, notices or points of clarification have been authorised to the text of the Series Articles of the above-named Series. It is recommended that in addition to retaining a copy of this bulletin, all parties modify the text of the regulations according to the following:

Accredited Series Article Amendment:

1. Insert new Article 10 as stated in the schedule below.
2. Insert new Article 11 as stated in the schedule below.

1. Item One:

10. IN-CAR CAMERAS

- 10.1 All cars shall be fitted with a forward-facing video camera which operates during qualifying and races.
- 10.2 All in-car camera installations shall be subject to inspection and approval by the Series Scrutineer and/or Chief Scrutineer of the Meeting.
- 10.3 In-car camera footage shall be made available and will be collected for use in Series promotional materials. Such recordings or data shall be provided unmodified in any way.
- 10.4 In-car camera footage shall be made available to the Clerk of the Course and/or Steward(s) on request. Such recordings or data shall be provided unmodified in any way.

Reason: *Introduce requirement for in-car camera installation and management.*

2. Item Two:

11. RACE RADIO

- 11.1 Race Radio will be used at all rounds. This requirement will be contained in round Supplementary Regulations along with the operating frequency.
- 11.2 Radio communications to Competitors during Practice, Qualifying and Races will be solely related to any safety-related matters where practicable.
- 11.3 Direct radio communications serve as a supplementary aid and shall not supersede any official signals conveyed to drivers.

Reason: *Introduce requirement for Race Radio installation and management.*
