Dylan Petch	<b>The Clerk of the Course finds that:</b> Car 51 caused a Red flag to be displayed during qualifying by spinning off the circuit at Turn 4 and being unable to rejoin. The position of the car was deemed unsafe.	<b>This is a breach of rule:</b> Appendix Four Schedule Z Article 9.2(C).	<b>The Clerk of the Course rules:</b> Dylan Petch is moved back 3 grid spaces in the starting grid for the Class 4/5 One Hour Race.
Max Wilson/Jamie Wilson	<b>The Clerk of the Course finds that:</b> Car 991 left the pits just as the finish flag was displayed. The car was in the acceleration zone which is deemed part of the pit lane. (Appendix 4 Sch Z 12.5(1) as the flag waved above Car 991. Due to this Car 991 was unable to take the finish flag as per 20:1.3 SIERDC/NZ Endurance Articles 1.9.1 at that time. Car 991 rather than crossing the finish line within 4 minutes pitted, and therefore did not finish. Car 991 is recorded in the results as a DNF.	<b>This is a breach of rule:</b> No rule breach established.	<b>The Clerk of the Course rules:</b> No penalty applies.
Grant Silvester	<b>The Clerk of the Course finds that:</b> Car 666 made contact with another car on the first lap causing an accident in which Car 35 Bruce Davidson Chevrolet Corvette sustained damage. For this Car 666 was issued a Drive Through Penalty and this was displayed at the start line. Car 666 did not serve this Drive Through Penalty. After a hearing with the Race Director Grant Silvester admitted he had not completed a Drive Through Penalty.	<b>This is a breach of rule:</b> Appendix Four Schedule Z Article 13.10.	<b>The Clerk of the Course rules:</b> fined a sum of \$100. Is excluded from the results of the race. No additional penalties are applied.
Matt Spratt & Hugh Gardiner	<b>The Clerk of the Course finds that:</b> Car 115 made contact with Car 31 Graeme Rhodes/Paul Rickerby Ford Mustang on the first lap causing damage to Car 31, Car 31 also lost position because of this contact. This has had a negative effect on Car 31.	<b>This is a breach of rule:</b> Appendix Four Schedule z Article 15.3	<b>The Clerk of the Course rules:</b> Car 115 Was issued a Drive Through Penalty .ind .this was displayed at the start line. Drive Through Penalty served.
Sam Filmore & Johnny Reid	<b>The Clerk of the Course finds that:</b> Maurice Thomson South Island Endurance Technical Officer reports a breach of PPE for Car 27. A team member over the Pit Box Control Line without the correct PPE.	<b>This is a breach of rule:</b> 2023 SIERDC/NZ Endurance Articles Item 4.4.	<b>The Clerk of the Course rules:</b> Car 27 Was issued a Drive Through Penalty and this was displayed at the start line. Drive Through Penalty served.

Car 112 has chased the Safety Car after it has extinguished its lights.	<b>This is a breach of rule:</b> Appendix Four Schedule Z Article 10.3 (1) (b)	<b>The Clerk of the Course rules:</b> Car 112 Is issued a 10 Second Time Penalty. The Penalty Board, Car Number and Flag were displayed.
