This resulted in car 15 spinning and losing track position. Steve Collier	The Stewards finds that: It is alleged that you have Breached the National Sporting Code 78(2) - Duties and Authority of Race Director by breaching article 3.1.1(a) of the 2023 Toyota 86 Championship articles (by breaching Schedule Z Article 13.2. - Restarting the Qualifying or the Race)	This is a breach of rule: As per NSC 76 (5) - the Stewards were made aware and observed the full race restart that was conducted after the suspension of Race 1 of the Toyota 86 Championship race at Hampton Downs which appeared to be conducted in contradiction with the code, namely Schedule Z. The Race Director, who admitted to the breach after being summoned to a hearing with the Stewards, incorrectly applied Sch Z Art 13.2 (b)(ii) ("Where the leader has completed more than one(l) lap but less than 75% of the scheduled distance or time") rather than applying Sch Z Art 13.2 (b) (i) ("If less than one(l) lap has been completed by the leader") which resulted in Car 14 to be incorrectly positioned at the rear of the field for the restart (which was by way of a grid start) rather than in position 2 - being disadvantaged. We also note that Car 14 has lodged an inquiry with the Race Director related to this matter.	The Steward rules: As per the National Sporting Code 77 (16) - the Stewards recommend to MotorSport NZ that it take disciplinary action against the Race Director in accordance with Articles 91 of the National Sporting Code.
